1. All exhibits to be staged by 10.45 am.
2. The tent will be closed for judging at 11.00 am. The judge's decision is final, and they are empowered to withhold prizes where exhibits are considered unworthy.
3. In the event of a joint placing, the number of firsts will be used to decide.
4. All exhibits in the Cookery Section **MUST BE COVERED**.
5. All entries must have been grown or made by the exhibitor and all garments must be unworn.
6. Presentation of the trophies will take place in the Horticultural Tent at 3.45 pm prompt. Prize money will be paid in the tent after the presentations.
7. No exhibits to be removed from the tent before 4.00 pm.
8. All exhibits to be collected from the tent by 5.00 pm.
9. All exhibitors to be responsible for their exhibits.
10. **NO MORE THAN 3 ENTRIES PER CLASS ACCEPTED.**

Entries to be received on the morning of the show.

It would be helpful if the entry form was filled in beforehand.

There is no entry fee for any exhibits in the Horticultural Section.
